

The Friulian Dolomites Natural Park

The Dolomia mineral water source is located in the Friulian Dolomites, within the Friulian Dolomites Natural Park. The Friulian Dolomites are part of the Dolomite Mountains declared a Unesco World Heritage Site on 26th June 2009, because of their highly distinctive and exceptionally beautiful landscape, and their scientific importance at a geological and geomorphological level. The Friulian Dolomites Natural Park is a piece of paradise. a heritage of all humanity whose purity is protected and preserved. It is known for its unspoilt environment and respect for flora and fauna.

Astounding beauty

The Dolomia mineral water source is located in Val Cimoliana, a long, deep valley that crosses the Friulian Dolomites Natural Park, wedged between Dolomite peaks that are almost 3,000 metres high.

The valley was shaped by the eroding action of glaciers which covered most of the area in the Last Ice Age which ended 10,000 years ago.


The "Stretta di Gote" in particular, offers spectacular scenery between high vertical walls separated by just a few metres as carved by erosion. The water which suddenly emerges, falls wildly in the torrent and plunges from the high cliffs.

The place, wild and unspoilt, gives real lovers of mountains the opportunity to immerse themselves in the deep silence that is to be enjoyed

during excursions. They can contemplate infinity as they marvel at the expanse of the perennial snowfields, at the roaring water of the inaccessible canyons, at the wintry spectacle of icefalls dangling along impracticable cliff sides.

The history of Dolomia: wisdom and experience

Dolomia was created thanks to the intuition of one of the company's founding members whom, whilst spending time in Val Cimoliana, was told by the area's older generation of a time when livestock coming down the valley from high mountain pastures liked to drink – out of the many springs available – at the spring situated at "gote", where Dolomia Water flows today.

It was known that here the water was good.
The first analyses gave very positive feedback on the water's properties and this was the motive that led to the launch of the initiative.

Gote: the source

Dolomia natural mineral water springs from the rock of the Eastern Dolomites, today Unesco World Heritage site, in Val Cimoliana, at 833 mamsl, in the Friulian Dolomites Natural Park, in an enchanting place with breathtaking scenery of rare beauty and an uncontaminated environment. A protected area, of great geological interest, with a magnificent variety of flora and fauna.

Water born from the rocks

Dolomia water flows from the dolomite rock, from which it derives its name.

Dolomite rock – specifically Main Dolomite – is particularly widespread in the area in which the Dolomia water source is found and it is one of the main components of the Dolomite Mountains.

Its formation dates back to the Late Triassic geological era, in particular to the Noricum and Rhaetian period, 200 million years ago!






The sound of "life": crystal clear water

One morning, like any other, Italo was taking a stroll through the woods. It was a spring day, the sun beamed down from a cloudless sky and yet the air was still fresh and crisp. Italo had decided to venture into the Friulian Dolomites Natural Park, along the Val Cimoliana as he frequently liked to do. He loved to walk, to savour the different smells around him and to take in all the sounds and colours of the mountain landscape. That morning, however, his attention was drawn inadvertently to a sound that he had never noticed before: the sound of gushing water. 
Gote


Gote means drop in Friulian language

Its low dry residue (TDS) of 114 mg/L, together with its balanced mineral composition, makes Dolomia Water pleasant to drink and particularly suitable as part of your daily diet, encouraging diuresis and eliminating uric acid.

Dolomia mineral water stands out due to its high level of dissolved oxygen - 10.5 mg/L - one of the highest values in the mineral water market. Oxygen is a gas naturally dissolved in spring water. Water is essential for our existence, and oxygen is essential for life. Oxygen leads to an improvement in our general well-being, has an energising effect and specific beneficial effects on many of the human body's organs.

Dolomia Water is characterised by a good concentration of calcium, an essential element for bone structure and vital physiological processes.

Dolomia Water guarantees magnesium intake, therefore helping to maintain the body's balance and wellbeing and is therefore particularly useful in athletes' diets.

The concentration of bicarbonates in our water is unique, thanks to the configuration and nature of the rock from which it springs. Helped by its alkaline nature, Dolomia Water is effective at stimulating gastric secretion and aiding digestion.

The presence of bicarbonate is useful for limiting acidosis caused by physical exercise.



Nitrates NO₃-2 mg/L Dolomia the water for children.

The purity of Dolomia Water is reflected also by its low nitrate content.

The World Health Organisation recommends a nitrate limit of 45 mg/L for mineral waters, and of 10 mg/L for waters intended for infants and pregnant women.



Thanks to its exceptionally low sodium content, it is the water most "recommended for low-sodium diets" and for the prevention of water retention. There are no consumption limits when recovery is required due to heavy sweating.

Dolomia, as created by a pristine environment, is for the well-being and drinking pleasure of all consumers who believe that not all waters are equal, who know that our bodies are mostly made of water that must be constantly replaced, and who therefore only choose the best.

2001

The company started in 2001 from a courageous idea of its founding members, who, thanks to the tales of the older generation of Cimolais (Pordenone, Italy), realised that the many sources of light, exceptionally pure mineral water that flowed in Val Cimoliana on the slopes of Cima Preti mountain, could be used, thanks to their initiative, to establish a bottling plant and create an important opportunity of sustainable development for the entire Valcellina mountain area.

2007

Construction of the water-intake system from the source at Gote inside the Val Cimoliana was completed, including over 8 km of water piping that leads right to the plant. Construction of Dolomia Water's modern bottling plant, including two bottling lines,



was also completed in the Municipality of Cimolais (PN), Pinedo, on a wide plain surrounded by beautiful and picturesque mountain scenery.

2008

Production and marketing of Dolomia mineral water began in late Spring 2008. The name of the water and the related brand was quickly identified as "Dolomía", which is the rock on which the water lies for a long time, absorbing its best components such as magnesium, calcium and bicarbonate, before flowing clear, cool and pure from the spring.


2009

The perception of the purity and environmental prestige of the mountains from which Dolomia water flows was authoritatively confirmed in 2009, when Unesco recognised the entire Friulian Dolomites Natural Park, where the Dolomia water source is located, as a Natural World Heritage Site.

2016

The installation of a new PET production line in Spring 2016 will offer an increased production capacity, thus ensuring and increasing the supply of products to current and future partners.




